ORDER APPROVING CLASS NOTICE PLAN

This 21st day of January, 2021, following review and consideration of Plaintiff’s Motion to Approve Plan for Class Notice (ECF 58), with no objection to the Plan having been raised, it is hereby **ORDERED** that the Motion is **GRANTED** as follows:

1. The Notice attached to Plaintiff’s Motion as Exhibit “A” satisfies the requirements of Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 23(c)(2), and is approved as to content and form;
2. American Legal Claims Services, LLC is approved as Class Administrator;
3. The Notice program proposed by Plaintiff is approved, and the timing of notice shall be as follows:
 - i. Within four weeks of the date of this order, the Class Administrator shall make publicly available the website www.TransUnionDisputeClassAction.com, which shall contain the Class Notice, the Class Complaint, the Answer, the Order Granting Class Certification and supporting Opinion, deadline(s) to act, and the language of the 502 Letter;

- ii. Within four weeks of the date of this order, the Class Administrator shall establish and maintain a toll-free telephone number for Class Member inquiries;
- iii. Within four weeks of the date of this order, the Class Administrator shall send Notice via email to class members for whom a valid email address has been located;
- iv. Within six weeks of the date of this order, the Class Administrator shall send a second round of Notice via email; and,
- v. Within eight weeks of the date of this order, the Class Administrator shall send Notice by U.S. Mail to any Class Member for whom no valid email address has been located or whose email notice has been returned as undeliverable.
